Dear Parents and Carers,

It's a bumper edition this week. Please take a few minutes to update yourself about current events in St. Fillan's and especially, to find out further details about the pantomime trip and Parents' Appointments.

#### **School clothing**

I seek your assistance in ensuring that your own child understands their responsibility for their own clothing. I have had numerous parents advise that their child has lost or misplaced an item of clothing. I'm sure you will appreciate that we cannot possibly keep tabs on every item of clothing a child wears to school. So, please ensure all clothing is marked clearly with your child's name. On a daily basis, we reinforce the importance of children taking responsibility for their own belongings including jackets and would appreciate this message being reinforced at home.

In addition, it is very important that all pupils have a change of clothing in schoolbags. In October, more than half of the pupils who required changing due to trips, falls or toilet accidents did not have another set of clothes. We ask that any clothing provided, including underwear, is washed and returned to school.

#### **JRSO News**

The Scottish Water work being undertaken continues to have a significant impact on the Road Safety around the school grounds. I kindly request that parents park away from the school and walk to the school gate as much as possible in order to ensure that the traffic isn't impacted. <u>I also</u> request that parents do not walk through the vehicle service entrance(car park gate) at the front of the school at any point during the day. We are still seeing parents do this on a daily basis.

#### **Scottish Water update**

#### A brief update regarding the work being undertaken in the area by Scottish Water

Works started this week on the area directly outside our school. There have been a series of different temporary traffic lights and parking restrictions in operation on Carmunnock Rd., Crompton Ave. and Elmore Ave. whilst the work is carried out. This traffic management will continue to require adaptations as different issues manifest. The section of road outside the school has been a particularly challenging but we implore everyone to continue to show the required patience to ensure the safety of all.

Access to properties and the school will be maintained at all times.

Children must take care around all working areas and to stay within pedestrian areas at all times when coming to and from school.

It is essential that Parents/Carers and visitors respect our neighbours and do not park across our neighbours' driveways. Thank you


Please appreciate that we will do our best to respond to you as soon as possible. Some messages will require a quicker response than others.
