Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for your understanding regarding the school closure and the short notice that we had to give. Please see the direct communication from Glasgow City Council director Douglas Hutchison which I have summarised below

'The council have made the decision to close all schools and nurseries to both staff and children and young people due to the severe weather conditions forecast tomorrow.

The Met Office has upgraded tomorrow's storm warning to RED with very strong winds associated with Storm Éowyn causing very dangerous conditions and significant disruption.'

The Council's social media channels will provide a further update, but they have asked schools to share this important update via our own channels.

There is no expectation that schoolwork should be provided or completed due to the short notice of closure and we understand the pressures that working from home and the extreme weather conditions may bring.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused to our families but everyone's safety is paramount in these circumstances. A retrospective payment for those entitled to free school meals will be added to the next holiday payment due to families.

Thank you once again for your support. Stay safe, and the expectation is for business as usual on Monday.
